APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED FOR ROSEMOUNT YOUTH COMMISSION

The Rosemount City Council will collect applications until March 18, 2015, for seats on the Youth Commission. The Commission gives teenagers in the City a forum to make their views known on community issues.

The City Council created the Rosemount Youth Commission in 2010. Its mission statement says it is intended to give young people “a leadership opportunity, to participate in government, and to represent and articulate the needs of youth in Rosemount.”

Since its creation, the Commission has met with City officials and community members; advised the City Council on various issues; and planned and promoted activities with the Rosemount Area Arts Council like the Swing Dance and Holiday Tree Lighting.

Membership on the Youth Commission is open to residents of the City of Rosemount between ages 14 and 18. Terms run for one year. The Commission typically meets at City Hall on the fourth Wednesday of each month from 3:45 to 4:45 p.m.

The City Council appoints new Commissioners after reviewing applications and conducting interviews. Current members of the Commission are eligible for reappointment.
