#### WATER SYSTEM MAINTENANCE TO BEGIN SOON

Rosemount city crews will begin flushing more than 1,200 fire hydrants beginning the week of April 13. The process helps clear mineral deposits from the water mains and ensures that each hydrant is in peak operating condition in case of emergency.

Occasionally this causes discolored water in homes and businesses. If this happens, residents are encouraged to run the water in all taps in their home until the water is clear again. Avoid doing laundry until the water runs clear for several minutes.

Also this year, Rosemount Public Works staff will continue a city-wide inspection of all water main shut-off valves throughout the water delivery system. Valves will be inspected, cleaned and repaired if necessary. This process - like hydrant flushing - can stir up deposits in the water mains. If you notice discolored water in your home or business any time this summer, please let your water run for several minutes to clear the lines. If you continue to have issues with discolored or odorous water, please call our Public Works department at 651-322-2022.
