

You Are Invited to a Public Open House for the US Highway 52 and CR 42 Interchange Reconstruction Project



Project Purpose

Dakota County and the City of Rosemount are planning to reconstruct the interchange at US Highway 52 and CR 42 to address safety and operational issues at the interchange.

Project Summary

CR 42 will be expanded from a two-lane to a four-lane highway which will improve the sight lines from the US Highway 52 off-ramps, and the US 52 bridges over CR 42 will be replaced. The interchange ramps will be reconstructed on similar alignments with dedicated turn lanes being added to off-ramps. Construction of the project is scheduled to begin in 2017. A concept and anticipated schedule are included in this newsletter.


The meeting will have an open house format. Feel free to stop in at your convenience any time between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
