## ROSEMOUNT ANNUAL FIRE OPEN HOUSE IS OCT. 11

The Rosemount Fire Department is opening its doors to spread safety tips at an open house on Sunday, October 11. Residents are invited to Fire Station No. 1, 14700 Shannon Parkway, to see equipment and demonstrations between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m.

Visitors can get an up-close view of fire trucks and gear. The event will feature a demonstration of an extrication from a vehicle accident and of how to handle kitchen fires. The North Memorial Air Care helicopter will arrive if weather and scheduling allow it.

There will also be an ambulance from HealthEast Medical Transportation and displays from the burn unit of the Hennepin County Medical Center and the Dakota Communications Center emergency dispatching service.

The Rosemount Fire open house follows National Fire Prevention Week, when members of the Department will visit area schools.

One new tool that Rosemount Firefighters will describe comes from a grant to the Department by Invisible Fence of the Twin Cities. It will pay for six kits specially designed to resuscitate animals. Oxygen masks will fit animals of various sizes that are overcome by smoke.
