## ROSEMOUNT CITY COUNCIL SETS GOALS AND INITIATIVES TO SERVE COMMUNITY

The Rosemount City Council last night approved revised goals and initiatives to meet City needs and maintain the community's quality of life.

The goals continue the Council's work to attract and support businesses, become a more sustainable community, and provide efficient and effective services.

Initiatives include plans for a bond referendum to ask Rosemount voters if they would support borrowing to build additional recreational facilities, including a new ice sheet, athletic fields at UMore Park and the Flint Hills Athletic Complex, and improvements in Central Park.

The referendum could be scheduled for as early as late spring. Details of the proposal will be determined by the Council later this winter.

The initiatives also call for creation of two citizen task forces. One would investigate environmental and sustainability issues. The other would study needs for replacement City government buildings.

The City Council discussed its plans during a two-day work session last month. The result will guide the work of City staff and the Council itself to prioritize work flow, budgeting decisions, and objectives.
