Rosemount, Minnesota

Q2, 2015

- 399 establishments with 8,528 covered jobs
 - \$61,932 annual average wage
 - 6,632 private sector jobs (78% of total)
- Healthy employment growth
 - City gained 420 total jobs over the year (5.2%)
 - Dakota County gained 3,698 total jobs (2.0%)
 - Private sector gained 389 jobs (6.2%)
 - Dakota County gained 3,685 private sector jobs (2.3%)





2000 – 2014












Rosemount Commute & Labor Sheds
