

MVTA Launches Service to St. Paul from Rosemount Transit Station

Rosemount, Minn. – (Feb. 23, 2016) – The Minnesota Valley Transit Authority (MVTA) has launched peak-period transit service between the Rosemount Transit Station and downtown St. Paul. Service began on Feb. 22.

Trips on Route 484 depart Rosemount at 6:32 and 7:02 a.m., arriving at Union Depot at 7:10 and 7:40 a.m. Afternoon trips on Route 484R depart Union Depot at 3:50 and 4:20 p.m., arriving at Rosemount Transit Station at 4:28 and 4:58 p.m. Buses travel into St. Paul via Highway 52. The fare is \$3 per ride.

“We are pleased to see this additional service for our Rosemount residents,” said Mayor Bill Droste, who also serves on the MVTA Board. The service is funded by federal Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) dollars awarded to the MVTA. Trips have also been added into St. Paul from Apple Valley, Burnsville and Eagan.
