The Rosemount Youth Commission Mission Statement:

To provide the Youth of Rosemount with a leadership opportunity, to participate in government, and to represent and articulate the needs of youth in Rosemount. To cultivate future leaders in an engagement process that takes place throughout the year on a variety of issues.

In creating the Youth Commission, the City Council recognized that many issues arise in City government and the community as a whole that may be of interest to youth or may affect youth. It benefits the community to develop citizenship skills of our youth by helping them work with local government on those issues. City government can directly benefit from the advice and efforts of youth in the community on the issues that confront the City.

Since it began work in 2010, the Commission has:

- met with City officials, department representatives and community leaders
- advised the City Council on issues of interest to the youth in the community
- conducted a Youth Summit and Goal Setting Session
- partnered with Rosemount Area Arts Council for Swing Dance event and future event planning
- partnered with the Rosemount Area Arts Council and the Rosemount Business Council for the Annual Tree Lighting.

Membership on the Youth Commission is open to residents of the City of Rosemount between 14 and 18 years of age. Terms run for one year, and Commissioners can be reappointed. The City Council appoints new Commissioners after reviewing applications and conducting interviews.

The Commission typically meets at City Hall on the fourth Wednesday of each month from 3:45 to 4:45 p.m.
